

# Job Description - Elk Run Farm Manager

Drylands Agroecology Research is seeking a Farm Manager to oversee operations at its pilot research project, Elk Run Farm. The ideal candidate will be organized, self-motivated, have good people management skills, and have 2-3 years of working experience with vegetable production and/or livestock husbandry.

Our operation is relatively small - veg production on 1/3 of an acre, forest garden/diverse orchard production, drylands grain fields, and rotational livestock management - sheep, chickens, pigs, ducks.

The position also includes on site housing.

#### **Summary:**

Elk Run Farm Manager interfaces directly with the Director of Regenerative Design (DRD) to ensure that all agricultural operations at Elk Run Farm are running smoothly for the purpose of:

- 1. Supplying food for the Elk Run community,
  - a. Maintaining and developing the regenerative land systems that are being researched and documented.

Elk Run Farm Manager also serves as a liaison between all agricultural practices at Elk Run and other daily programs, such as, but not limited to, Folk Farm School (young childhood education program, ages 3-8)

## Communication Strategy

- Weekly check in with DRD (Nick)
  - Weekly walk and assessment of tasks, prepare task list

- Weekly Farm Meeting
  - Begin by co-leading w/ DRD, transition to leading as comfort increases
- Specify Manner of Communication when/how/what forms (email, text, call)

### Main responsibilities

- Preparing weekly task list to review with DRD (Nick) on monday
- Leading team of interns and volunteers to accomplish all weekly tasks, as agreed upon by DRD (Nick) and Farm Manager
- Tracking Intern time exchanges/schedules
  - Google doc/spreadsheet/google calendar?
- Livestock
  - Ensure animals are fed and watered daily
    - Animals all have adequate food alert DRD when chicken or pig grain is down to 1 barrel
    - Ensure pickups of local spent grain and food scraps occur weekly and are dropped at appropriate locations
      - Task delegated to intern(s)
    - Maintain livestock infrastructure Fencing, stock tanks, structures
    - Implement rotational plan developed with Nick
      - Coordinate electric fence movements
    - Monitor health and well being
      - Farm manager does animal chores once per week?
      - Interns all do chores together for a period of time?
    - Maintain Rotational Grazing Spreadsheet records
  - o Forest Garden
    - Prep all beds in sequence co-planned by DRD and Farm Manager
    - Implement Planting Plan developed with DRD
    - Keep beds mulched and weeded
    - Track supplies like straw/hay, compost alert DRD when supplies are low
    - Irrigation infrastructure is monitored and maintained
  - Staple Grain Fields
    - Manages field prep/planting with Nick
    - Monitors weeding maintenance
    - Monitors irrigation infrastructure

### Secondary Responsibilities

- Delegate errands and side tasks outside of main responsibilities
  - Receive Direction from DRD
- Awareness of group morale/energy
- Maintain Elk Run Code of Conduct
- Keep Farm tidy (exception for public events)
- trash/recycling taken out weekly
- Tools are organized and clean
- Common spaces are clean
  - o Outdoor kitchen
  - Upper Deck
- Communicate with DRD immediately if any equipment, tools, or infrastructure is damaged
- Maintain awareness of farm truck/pickups trailer oil level, maintenance, tire pressure,
  - Delegate all truck/trailer maintenance items every Friday

### **Expectations**

- 35 hrs/week
- All hours clocked in Google Sheets

#### Compensation

- Monetary start at \$1400/month, increase by \$100 each month up to \$1800/month (negotiable at rate the onboarded Farm Manager is self sufficient)
- Exchange:
  - Housing value of \$450/month
  - Food
    - Farm meats \$210/month approximate value (1/2lb per day, 3.5lbs/week, 14lbs/month, valued @ \$15/lb)
    - Farm Veg = \$140 approximate value (\$30/week)
    - Sauces, krauts = \$50 approximate value/week
    - Staple goods = \$30 approximate value/week

Total food approximate value = \$430/month

Total approximate exchange value = \$880/month

Total starting aggregate exchange = \$2,280/month (\$16.28/hr) NEGOTIABLE FOR SKILLED CANDIDATE

Max 2022 aggregate exchange = \$2,680/month (\$19.14/hr)
